Man injured in afternoon shooting

*****UPDATE*****

The man injured in this shooting succumbed to his injuries earlier this morning. The investigation is still ongoing.

Shreveport Police are investigating a shooting that left a Shreveport man seriously injured earlier this afternoon.

On June 2, 2018 just after 1:00 pm, Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to the 1500 block of Claiborne Avenue on reports of a shooting. Officers arrived on scene and located the **18-year-old** victim suffering from at least one gunshot wound to the head. He was immediately transported to University Health Hospital with life threatening injuries.

Investigators with the Violent Crimes and Crime Scene Units responded to the scene and began combing the scene for evidence. Several pieces of evidence were collected and witnesses were interviewed. Investigators believe that the victim was sitting outside of the rehabilitation center where he was currently residing when an unknown slender built black male wearing red clothing and armed with a handgun approached him and fired several shots in his direction, striking him at least once. The investigation continues at this hour.
