Man arrested in charged if Attempted Murder and Armed Robbery



Suspect Timonezelle Willeams

Shreveport Police have a man in custody accused of robbing and shooting at two others in late May.

On May 30, 2018, just before 8:30 pm Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to reports of shots being fired at the corner of Alabama Avenue and West Jordan Street. Arriving officers made contact with two victims who advised that they were sitting in a vehicle near the intersection when a black Chevy Tahoe drove up and two black males armed with handguns exited the vehicle demanding that they surrender their belongings. The men surrendered undisclosed property to the suspects. One of the suspects fired several shots at the victims after the robbery before fleeing the scene in the black Tahoe. Neither victim was injured in the encounter. Officers were able to located and recover shell casing from the scene.

Investigators with the Tactical Robbery Unit were assigned to the case. Through their investigation, they were able to identify 22-year-old Timonezelle Williams, of the 3000 block of Catherine Street as the suspect they believed fired the shots following the robbery.

On June 13 patrol officers spotted Williams near Portland Avenue and Stonewall Street. He was driving a black Tahoe matching the description given by the robbery victims. Williams was taken into custody and following interviews with detectives was booked into the Shreveport City Jail on one count of Attempted 2nd Degree Murder and one count of Armed Robbery. The investigation is ongoing.
