Crime Stoppers tip leads to arrest of robbery suspect

A tip received through Shreveport Caddo Crime Stoppers has helped put a man behind bars, accused of attempting to rob another at a local convenience store then leading police on a high-speed chase.

On June 12, 2018, just after 5:00 am, Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to reports of an armed person at a convenience store in the 9400 block of Mansfield Road. On arrival, officers made contact with the victim who stated that he was pumping gas when an unknown black male approached him in a black minivan, pointed a handgun at him, and told him to "give him that". The victim was frightened and jumped into his vehicle. The suspects sped away and the victim followed until officers were able to locate them. When officers attempted to stop the vehicle a pursuit ensued. The suspect eventually stopped and exited the vehicle on foot and escaped capture. Officers later learned that the vehicle was stolen.

Investigators released photos extracted from store video in hopes of getting the suspect identified. Late last week Shreveport Police received a tip through Shreveport Caddo Crime Stoppers identifying the man as 17-year-old Jalan Taylor, of the 2600 block of Lola Lane. On June 15, 2018, detectives procured a warrant for Taylor charging him with one count of Attempted Armed Robbery with bond set at \$150,000.00. More charges are expected as this investigation continues.
