Warrant issued for suspect in officer involved shooting



Suspect Nicholas Parks

Shreveport Police detectives are seeking the whereabouts of a man wanted for allegedly firing multiple shots at Shreveport Police officers following a traffic stop Saturday afternoon in west Shreveport. Just before 4:00 p.m. on June 30, 2018, two Shreveport Police patrol officers were conducting a traffic stop on a silver four door sedan in the 4300 block of Wallace Avenue, when a passenger inside the vehicle opened the front passenger door and began firing shots at officers on scene there. Officers returned fire at the suspect, who managed to elude officers on foot. Investigators identified the subject as Isaiah J. Martin, 20, of the 3000 block of Bibb Street. Martin remains outstanding. No officers were shot or seriously injured during the incident, although one officer was taken to a local hospital for evaluation. Police detained the driver of the sedan, 18 year old Nicholas Parks of the 3700 block of Glencrest Street in Shreveport. Parks was later arrested and charged with no driver's license and flight. Police are now searching for Martin, who is wanted on charges of Attempted First Degree Murder of a Police Officer. Bond in the matter has been set a half a million dollars. 

Remarks: Upon contact with Martin during a traffic stop, Martin produced a semi-auto handgun and fired at SPD # point blank. Martin then ran off firing an additional shot at police officers. Martin should be considered armed and dangerous and willing to engage police in gunfire. Martin was last seen running at Wallace and Earl with his weapon. Witness statements indicate Martin has said he can't go back to jail.
