Warrant issued in domestic abuse incident



Suspect Jack Samuel III

Investigators with the Shreveport Police Department's Homicide Unit have procured a warrant for a man accused of battering and strangling a woman outside of a west Shreveport home Sunday night.

On July 9, 2018, Shreveport Police responded to University Health Hospital on reports of a victim of an alleged domestic battery arriving at the hospital for treatment. Due to the nature of the victim's injuries, investigators with the Homicide division were summoned.

When investigators arrived, they learned that the victim and her boyfriend, Jack Samuel III, 45, of the 1500 block of Camille Street were involved in an argument that turned violent when Samuel allegedly struck the victim multiple times in the face with his fist then strangled her unconscious. The victim was able to flee on foot to a nearby gas station where a stranger aided in her escape. On July 11, 2018, investigators procured a warrant for Samuel's arrest charging him with one count of Domestic Abuse Battery Strangulation. He has no bond set.
