Police apprehend man accused of Attempted Murder



Suspect Nazavion Chatman

Shreveport Police have a man in custody charged with shooting two people at a west Shreveport home early Sunday morning.

On July 14, 2018 just before 9:00 a.m., Shreveport Police patrol officers were dispatched to Willis Knighton North hospital on reports of a male and a female arriving there by private automobile suffering from gunshot wounds. The female victim, 19-year-old Jeromeka Anderson, was suffering from at least one gunshot wound to the abdomen. Her injuries were described as life threatening. The male, 19-year-old Derrick Davis, sustained multiple gunshot injuries that were considered non-life threatening.

Investigators with the Homicide and Crime Scene Units responded to the original crime scene in the 3400 block of Stonewall Street. Investigators interviewed witnesses and collected physical evidence that led them to believe that several people inside of the home were arguing and 20-year-old Nazavion Chatman allegedly pulled a weapon and shot Davis and Anderson. Based on the information they gathered they were able to procure a warrant for Chatman charging him with two counts of Attempted 2nd Degree Murder. The total bond amount was \$1,000,000.00.

On July 16, 2018, patrol officers took Chatman into custody at his home in the 2700 block of Frederick Street. Following interviews, he was booked into the Shreveport City Jail.
