### **Crime Stoppers tip aids investigators in identifying robbery suspect**

Shreveport Police investigators are searching for a man believed responsible for an armed robbery in downtown Shreveport last week.

On July 10, 2018, just before 1:00 a.m., Shreveport Police responded to an armed robbery in the 200 block of Spring Street. Officers arrived and contacted the victim who reported that he parked his vehicle in the alleyway and as he exited a black male with low cut hair pointed a handgun at him and demanded money. The victim surrendered an undisclosed amount of cash and two cell phones. The suspect fled on foot and got into what was described as a cream-colored Mercury Grand Marquis.

On July 13, 2018, the victim contacted investigators and advised that he had photographs of the subject that robbed him. The victim explained that the suspect took photos of himself and they automatically uploaded to his cloud and he was able to retrieve them. Investigators released photos of the suspect to the public in hopes of getting the subject identified. Within two days Shreveport Caddo Crime Stoppers delivered a tip that identified the alleged suspects as 27-year-old Tommy Lee Beverly Jr. of the 3100 block of Devaughn Street. Investigators conducted a follow up into the claim and subsequently procured an arrest warrant charging Beverly with one count of Armed Robbery. Bond was set at \$300,000.00.
