Police investigate domestic-related shooting

Shreveport Police are investigating an early morning west Shreveport shooting that left a man injured.

On July 22, 2018, just before 5:00 a.m., Shreveport Police responded to the 2900 block of Amherst Street on reports of a shooting. Officers arrived and found 31-year-old Jock Hines suffering from a single gunshot wound to the abdomen. He was transported to University Health Hospital with what was described as non-life threatening injuries.

Investigators with the Violent Crimes and Crime Scene Units responded to the scene. Following crime scene examination and interviews, investigators believe that Hines went to his estranged wife's home and gained entry into her residence by removing the window a/c unit in one of the rooms. His estranged wife and her friend were sleeping when Hines entered the room and allegedly began chasing the man. Investigators believe that Hines caught the man and the man was unable to escape. The man reportedly pulled a handgun and fired one round at Hines, striking him in the abdomen. No charges have been filed at this time. The investigation is ongoing.
