Shreveport woman charged in fatal shooting



Suspect Aliyah Morris

A Shreveport woman has been arrested for her alleged role in the shooting death of a local man earlier this week in west Shreveport.

Back on July 22, 2018, Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to the Aspen Apartments located in the 9700 block of Baird Road relative to a shooting. As officers arrived at the scene, it was learned a male subject was suffering a gunshot wound to the head. The man, identified as 21 year old Joshua Musgrove, was pronounced deceased at the scene. Police detained 18 year old Aliyah Morris at the scene, subsequently transporting her to Shreveport Police headquarters for questioning.

Morris, who was involved in a romantic relationship with Musgrove, was not charged in her initial dealings with police detectives; however, as the inquiry moved forward, additional information and evidence was obtained leading to the procurement of an arrest warrant for Morris who is now faced with a single count of Second Degree Murder. Morris was taken into police custody Thursday July 26, following additional interviews with investigators. Morris has a bond set at \$350,000.00. If convicted, Morris faces a mandatory sentence of life in prison without the possibility of parole.
