Suspect sought in fatal shooting

Shreveport Police investigators are seeking the identity of the person or persons responsible for a Sunday afternoon shooting which left one man dead and a 15 year old juvenile critically injured.

Shortly after 4:30 p.m. on July 29, 2018, Shreveport Police patrol officers were dispatched to the intersection of Jewella Avenue at Jackson Street relative to a shooting. As officers arrived at the scene, they located two victims, each suffering serious injuries sustained from gunshots. Both victims were transported to University Health hospital where the adult male was pronounced deceased a short time later.

Preliminary findings by investigators suggests the teen and another individual were walking along a portion of Jewella Avenue near Jackson Street when a vehicle of unknown description passed by and fired multiple shots, several which struck and critically injured the teen. It is further believed the adult victim was driving eastbound along Jackson Street approaching Jewella Avenue when shots rang out, striking the man, mortally wounding him. At current, detectives have not drawn a link between the teen and the 42 year old male victim. At this hour authorities are working tirelessly to determine the identity of the perpetrators of this crime.
