Two arrested, one summonsed following mid-day melee

Three people have been charged following their alleged involvement in a street fight where shots were fired in the Queensborough neighborhood earlier today.

On July 30, 2018, just before 12:00 p.m. Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to reports of multiple people fighting in the roadway in the 3500 block of Hardy Street. As officers were making their way to the call, they received reports that shots were being fired in the same block. Arriving patrol officers took two females, 28-year-old Tea Darby of the 2600 block of Village Lane in Bossier City and 42-year-old Tamiko Warf of the 3500 block of Hardy Street into custody. They also arrested a man, 29-year-old Gregory Warf, of the 3500 block of Hardy Street.

During their investigation officers learned that Darby's dog allegedly entered onto the Warf's property and relieved itself, which angered the couple. An argument ensued and a fistic encounter between the three followed. Several bystanders attempted to intervene and stop the fight. At some point Gregory Warf retreated into his home and allegedly armed himself with a 9mm handgun, exited the residence, and fired multiple rounds into a tree in the yard. Officers were able to locate and seize the weapon and several shell casings from the scene. No one was shot during the incident.

Darby and Tamiko Warf were both charged with Disturbing the Peace by Fighting and Gregory Warf was charged with Disturbing the Peace by Fighting and Illegal use of a Weapon. Darby and Gregory Warf were booked into the Shreveport City Jail. Tamiko Warf was summonsed and released.
