Police seek identity of burglars

On July 21, 2018, Shreveport Police received reports of a vehicle burglary in the 100 block of Chelsea Drive. The victim reported that he had been on vacation and returned to find his vehicle burglarized and a gun taken from within.

Investigators assigned to the case were able to retrieve video from the victim's home surveillance cameras. The burglary occurred on July 14, 2018. The video shows a black male exit a van/SUV and approach the victim's vehicle. The suspect entered the truck through an unlocked door and immediately located and took a handgun and returned to the van/SUV. Another black male entered the driver's side of the vehicle and began plundering through the contents. The suspect that initially entered the vehicle returned to the car and helped the second suspect continue to rummage through the vehicle. The van proceeded down the street and the two suspects eventually left on foot.
