## **Man charged in shots fired incident in local park**

Shreveport Police have charged a local man in connection with a shots fired call in a west Shreveport park Thursday.

Just after 9:30 p.m. on August 9, 2018, Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to Airport Park recreation center after concerned citizens reported hearing what sounded like multiple gun shots emitting from the park. Citizens were able to provide responding officers a description of a vehicle believed to be connected to the shots fired call and a direction the vehicle was last observed traveling.

As officers circulated the surrounding area, they soon located a vehicle fitting the description of the one provided by citizens near the intersection of Broadway Avenue at Hollywood Avenue. Authorities made contact with two individuals sitting in a white sport utility vehicle and were able to gather information and evidence linking the vehicle and its occupants to the initial call. Upon further investigation, a weapon believed used in the crime was seized, along with other firearm related articles. Based on additional information gathered at the scene, police arrested and charged 18 year old Malik Muscove, of the 4000 block of Andrea Street with one count of Illegal Use of a Weapon. Muscove was later booked into the Shreveport City Jail. A second man inside the vehicle was not charged.
