### **CORRECTION: Warrant obtained for suspect in July shooting**

**CORRECTION:** Jeremy Taylor's warrant for Aggravated Assault with a Firearm is in connection with an aggravated assault on his estranged girlfriend which occurred on July 28, 2018 in which Taylor reportedly arrived at the woman's Tower Drive residence, punched her in the face and threatened her with a firearm in the presence of their minor child.

It should be noted, although investigators continue to seek additional insight regarding the shooting described in the below release, Taylor has NOT been named a suspect or charged in connection with the shooting which occurred at the victims home hours later. He does however, remain wanted in connection to the aforementioned aggravated assault. Please reflect this change in your reporting thanks, Marcus.

### **Warrant obtained for suspect in July shooting**

Shreveport Police investigators are seeking the whereabouts of a man suspected of a drive-by shooting which injured a local woman last month.

Back on July 28, 2018, Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to the 3200 block of Tower Drive relative to a shooting. As officers arrived at the scene of the crime, it was learned an adult female had been struck multiple times by gunfire after a male apparently drove past a residence and fired multiple rounds from a moving vehicle. Two other individuals present at the scene suffered minor injuries in their attempts to escape the gunfire.

Since the investigation began, detectives with the Shreveport Police Department's Violent Crimes Unit have worked tirelessly in their efforts to secure information and evidence which has led them to name 30 year old Jeremy Taylor as the suspect in the shooting. Taylor, of the 3000 block of Terry Street in Shreveport, is now wanted on an outstanding arrest warrant with charges of Aggravated Assault with a Firearm. Bond in the matter has been set at \$150,000.00.
