Man injured in overnight shooting

Investigators with the Shreveport Police Department are investigating an overnight shooting that left a man seriously injured in north Shreveport.

On August 13, 2018, just after 8:00 p.m., Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to the 2100 block of Legardy Street on reports of a shooting. Arriving officers located the victim, 34-year-old JaMichael Armstrong, who was suffering from at least one gunshot injury to the upper body. Armstrong told officers that he was riding his bicycle in the block and an unknown black male, armed with a handgun, approached him and fired multiple shots in his direction, striking him at least once. The suspect then fled the scene on foot. Armstrong was transported to University Health Hospital with what was described as life-threatening injuries.

Investigators with the Violent Crimes Unit and Crime Scene Units responded to the scene. Evidence was collected and detectives spoke with several witnesses who advised that they did not see the incident unfold. The investigation is ongoing.
