Woman jailed in felony hit and run

A Shreveport woman is now in police custody following her arrest in connection with a fatal hit and run accident Wednesday morning in north Shreveport.

Just after 3:00 a.m. on August 22, 2018, Shreveport Police patrol officers were dispatched to a pedestrian accident at the intersection on Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Drive at Interstate 49. As officers arrived at the location, it was learned an adult male was deceased after being struck by a vehicle which left the scene. Officials with the Caddo Parish Coroner's Office have identified the man as 54 year old Danny Reed of Shreveport.

Shreveport Police Crash investigators were informed of the accident and arrived at the scene and began their probe of the incident. During the course of the investigation, information and evidence gathered at the scene of the crime, led authorities to 18 year old Brianna Savannah. It is alleged Savannah was driving the vehicle which struck Reed and later drove away from the crash site. At the time of the crime, Savannah was operating a 2006 Cadillac STS. Investigators were able to locate Savannah at her residence in the 3000 block of Lunn Street, where she was taken into police custody. Following interviews with investigators, Savannah was booked into the Shreveport City Jail on charges of felony hit and run and driving with a suspended driver's license.
