Arrest made in late night shooting

Shreveport Police have arrested two people in connection with a shooting in the Mooretown neighborhood late last night.

On August 26, 2018, just before 11:50 pm, Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to reports of a shooting in the 4600 block of Emerson Avenue. Arriving officers contacted 21-year-old Freddy Daniels who was suffering from multiple gunshot injuries to the upper body. Long was transported to University Health Hospital with what was described as life-threatening injuries. Investigating officers were able to determine that the shooting actually took place in the 4300 block of Long Street. After securing the crime scene Investigators were summoned.

Investigators with the Violent Crimes Bureau worked through the night combing through evidence and interviewing witnesses. Through their investigation, they learned that Freddy Daniels was the alleged suspect in a number of thefts from a home in the 4300 block of Long Street. Detectives made contact with Martez Hulbin, 27, and Bianca Hulbin, 26, both of the 4300 block of Long Street and following witness interviews and evidence assessment deduced that that Martez Hulbin allegedly shot Daniels after accusing him of the thefts. Investigators believe that after Daniels was shot, Bianca Hulbin concealed the firearm used in the crime. Martez Hulbin was charged with one count each of Attempted Second Degree Murder and Felon in Possession of a Firearm. Bianca Hulbin was charged with Obstruction of Justice. Both were booked into the Shreveport City Jail following interviews with investigators.
