Three injured in early morning shooting

Shreveport Police are investigating an early morning shooting that left men injured at a downtown Shreveport nightclub.

On September 2, 2018, just before 3:00 a.m., Shreveport Police downtown units responded to reports of a shooting at Styles Nigh Club in the 200 block of Texas Avenue. Arriving officers located Lavaisa Smith, 22, and Fern Roberson, 26, on the sidewalk in front of a business next door. One was suffering a gunshot injury to the shoulder and the other a graze wound to the lip. Officers located the third victim, Keyondray Lyons, 22, inside of the nightclub. Lyons was suffering a gunshot injury to the back of the neck. All of the men were transported to University Health Hospital, Smith and Roberson with non-life threatening injuries and Lyons with possible life-threatening injuries.

Investigators with the Violent Crimes and Crime Scene Units responded to the scene and began the process of collecting physical evidence and gathering witness statements. The witnesses did not provide details of the incident and neither did the victims. The investigation is ongoing.

Those who would like to give their information but wish to remain anonymous are asked to call Shreveport Caddo Crime Stoppers at 318-673-7373, lockemup.org, or via their app, P3Tips. Crime Stoppers is an anonymous tip service that pays cash money for information that leads to the arrest of individuals responsible for crimes.
