Police charge man with west Shreveport murder



Suspect Kadarius Jenkins

Investigators with the Shreveport Police Department have jailed a man in connection with a fatal shooting incident that happened in late July.

Shortly after 4:30 p.m. on July 29, 2018, Shreveport Police patrol officers were dispatched to the intersection of Jewella Avenue and Jackson Street on reports of a shooting. Arriving officers located an adult male and juvenile male victim suffering from gunshot injuries. Both victims were transported to University Health hospital. The adult male, 42-year-old Sheddrick Jackson, later died.

Investigators with the Violent Crimes and Crime Scene Units responded to the scene and began the process of collecting evidence and witness statements. Investigators learned that the teen and another individual were walking along a portion of Jewella Avenue near Jackson Street when multiple shots were fired that struck the juvenile. Sheddrick Jackson was driving eastbound down Jackson Street and was struck as he was driving his vehicle. Investigators later determined that Jackson was not the intended target.

Diligent investigators used evidence collected at the scene and witness statements to develop 17-year-old Kadarius Jenkins, of the 2700 block of Regent Street, as the alleged shooter. On September 5, 2018, investigators procured warrants charging Jenkins with one count of Attempted Second Degree Murder. Bond was set at \$250,000.00. Following his apprehension, Jenkins was also charged with one count of Second Degree Murder.
