Man charged following domestic related shooting incident



Suspect Clayton Davis

Shreveport Police have a man in custody following a domestic incident that led to shots being fired at a man.

On September 22, 2018, Shreveport Police responded to reports of shots fired in the 3100 block of Cedar Creek Drive. Arriving officer learned that the victim's estranged husband arrived at the home and forced his way into the residence and fired shots at her male companion. Nobody was injured in the incident.

Investigators with the Violent Crimes Unit launched a follow up investigation and following interviews with the victims and witnesses, were able to procure a warrant charging 30-year-old Clayton Davis with Attempted Second Degree Murder. His bond was set at \$250,000.00. Davis surrendered himself to authorities at Caddo Correctional Center.
