Early morning shooting leaves woman and child injured

Shreveport Police continue their investigation into an early morning shooting that left a woman and a child injured in west Shreveport early this morning.

On October 9, 2018, just before 3:30 a.m., Shreveport Police responded to reports of a shooting in the 4100 block of Barbara Street. On arrival, officers located 20-year-old Que' Lexus Hunter and a one-year-old female each suffering a single gunshot injury to the leg. Both were transported to Ochsner Health for treatment.

Investigators with the Shreveport Police Department's Violent Crimes Unit were called to the scene and launched an investigation into the ordeal. Detectives learned that shots were fired into the residence from outside of the home. Hunter and the child were sleeping in a bedroom inside of the residence when they were shot. Investigators with the Crime Scene Investigations Unit collected shell casings and evidence from the scene. An adult male was also present at the residence during the time of the shooting but was unable to give a suspect description or motive for the shooting. The investigation continues at this hour.
