## **Shreveport Police arrest man accused of robbery**

Shreveport Police have arrested a local man believed responsible for a series of armed robberies of individuals during the month of November and December.

On November 30, 2018 just after 8:00 p.m., Shreveport Police responded to reports of an armed robbery in the 2100 block of North Hearne Avenue. Upon officers' arrival, they contacted two victims who advised they had come to the location in attempts to purchase a cell phone from a seller they had met via a social media site. It was learned that during the incident, the suspect reportedly walked up to the driver's side of the victim's car, brandishing a handgun, demanding cash. Both victims complied with the suspects demands. Following the robbery the bandit fled the scene.

Investigators with Shreveport Police Department's Robbery Task Force were assigned to the case, and through their meticulous investigation, were able to identify 20-year-old Darreon Moore of the 100 block of Merrick Street, as the alleged robber. A warrant was procured for Moore's arrest charging him with two counts of Armed Robbery. Moore was arrested shortly after 5:00 p.m. on December 11th in the 1100 block of Shreveport-Barksdale Highway after he was spotted by investigators inside a local retail store. Following his arrest, Moore was transported to the Shreveport Police Headquarters where he was interviewed regarding his alleged involvement in the aforementioned crimes. It was later learned Moore was also implicated in another armed robbery of an individual occurring back on December 9th in the 2100 block of North Hearne Avenue, where a male was robbed in a similar fashion as the initial two victims. Following subsequent interviews, Moore was booked into the Shreveport City Jail and faces multiple counts of armed robbery and armed robbery with a firearm.
