Warrant issued for man accused of December shooting

Shreveport Police Violent Crimes investigators are seeking the whereabouts of a Shreveport man accused of a 2018 shooting.

Back on December 24, 2018, Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to the 200 block of Oregon Drive relative to a shooting. As officers arrived at the scene, it was learned the victim, 32 year old Arthur Jackson, had been transported to the hospital after allegedly being shot by 34 year old Demarion Mitchell. Authorities believe Mitchell shot Jackson after striking him in the head with a handgun following a verbal dispute.

Jackson's injuries were not considered life-threatening. At current authorities are searching for Mitchell in connection with the shooting. A warrant charging Mitchell with one count each of convicted felon with a firearm and aggravated battery was signed by a Caddo Parish District Judge, with an attached bond amount of \$150,000.00.
