Shreveport Police make arrest in 2018 shooting

Chief Ben Raymond announces arrest in connection with the attempted murder of a man late last year.

On November 2, 2018, just before 11:00 p.m., Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to the 5900 block of Canal Street on reports of shots fired. Arriving officers located 21-year-old Darien Adams suffering from at least two gunshot wounds to the upper body. He was transported to Ochsner LSU Health with what was described as life-threatening injuries. Adams continues his recovery.

Detectives with the Violent Crimes and Crime Scene Investigation Unit responded to the scene and launched their investigation. Detectives interviewed witnesses, and the crime scene unit collected shell casings and other evidence left at the scene.

During the ongoing investigation, detectives were able to identify 29-year-old Christopher Williams of the 4300 block of Lakeshore Drive as the alleged shooter. A warrant was procured for Williams charging him with one count of Attempted Second Degree Murder. Bond was set at \$500,000.00. On February 1, 2019, Williams was taken into custody by patrol officers during a traffic stop. He was booked into the Shreveport City jail on his warrant and is currently being held at the Caddo Correctional Center.
