Shreveport Police make arrest in cold case homicide

Shreveport Police Chief Ben Raymond announces an arrest in connection with the June 2016 slaying of an elderly man in west Shreveport.

On June 19, 2016, Shreveport Police patrol officers and investigators responded to a home in the 2400 block of Parham Drive relative to a homicide. Police discovered 81-year-old William Hines deceased within the residence. An autopsy determined that Hines died as a result of multiple stab wounds. Detectives interviewed witnesses and collected evidence from the scene, but were unable to make an arrest at that time.

Based on information and evidence gathered during the ongoing investigation, detectives were able to develop 61-year-old Ernest Manshack, of the 4500 block of Monkhouse Drive, as the person they believe responsible for the murder of Hines. Manshack was arrested and charged with one count of Second Degree Murder and was booked into the Shreveport City Jail. Manshack was later transferred to Caddo Correctional Center where he is being held on a \$200,000.00 bond.
