Two charged; one injured in Monday shooting

Two men are behind bars, while another man remains hospitalized following a Monday afternoon shooting which occurred in the 500 block of Allen Avenue.

Shortly after 3:30 p.m. on March 11, 2019, Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to the 500 block of Allen Avenue relative to a male who was suffering a gunshot wound to the chest. The man, identified as 41 year old Derrick Montgomery, was taken by ambulance to Ochsner's LSU Hospital where he was treated for injuries considered to be life-threatening.

Based on preliminary information gathered at the scene of the crime, investigators learned the victim was shot at his residence following a verbal altercation involving two men identified as Willie Rochelle and Marvin Rochelle. Both previously mentioned men reportedly arrived at Montgomery's residence at which time the trio engaged in an exchange of gunfire. Following the shooting both alleged suspects left the home. Authorities were able to locate Willie and Marvin at which time each man was detained for their alleged roles in the shooting. Following interviews with detectives, Willie Rochelle III 41, and Marvin Rochelle 22, were each charged with a single count of attempted second degree murder and booked into the Shreveport City Jail.
