There was a water main breach in or near your area. The water was cut off for repairs.

**Site Location(s): All Shreveport water customers North of Ravendale Road and Martin Luther King Drive; East of Interstate 49; and West and South of Old Mooringsport Road.**

The water supplied by our distribution system to your facility may be of questionable microbiological quality.

Therefore, as a precaution, the Department of Water & Sewerage is issuing a VOLUNTARY BOIL ADVISORY effective when your service is restored, until sample(s) collected and analyzed indicate the absence of coliform bacteria.

It is recommended that water be disinfected before consuming it (including fountain drinks), making ice, brushing teeth, or using it for food preparation or rinsing of foods by the following means:

**Boil water for one (1) full minute in a clean container. The one minute starts after the water has been brought to a rolling boil. (The flat taste can be eliminated by shaking the water in a clean bottle or pouring it from one clean container to another)**

Again, please be sure to disinfect your own water prior to consumption until you have been advised otherwise.

When satisfactory laboratory test results are obtained, the Department of Water & Sewerage with approval from the Department of Health and Hospitals, will then rescind the Boil Advisory and notify you that the water has been deemed safe.
