Arrest made in April slaying

A Shreveport man is now in police custody, charged in the April shooting death of a man killed in west Shreveport.

Back on April 11, 2019, Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to the 3000 block of Hoyte Drive relative to a shooting. As officers arrived at the scene of the crime it was learned the male victim, identified as 26 year old Cartell Willis, was suffering multiple gunshot wounds to the upper body. Willis was pronounced deceased on scene.

Since the investigation into the shooting began, authorities have worked around the clock in search of the person responsible for the shooting. Those efforts came to fruition Monday afternoon with the arrest of 22 year old Shacortez Monroe. Monroe was arrested with the assistance of agents from the United States Marshals Office Fugitive Task Force. Monroe was located and arrested at an apartment complex in the 2900 block of Peach Street. In addition to the arrest of Monroe, three additional persons were taken into custody inside the apartment and charged with narcotics violations. Haston Smith (3/3/92), Antravion Johnson (11/05/96) and Tramarceia Ruffins (5/21/93) each face charges of possession of schedule I and possession of schedule II with intent to distribute.
