Three men arrested, charged after unintended victim shot and killed

Three local men are now in police custody, charged in their alleged roles in the shooting death of a Shreveport man Sunday evening.

Just before 8:00 p.m. on Sunday September 1, 2019, Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to the 300 block of East Stoner Avenue relative to a shooting. As officers arrived at the scene, it was learned 42 year old Sherman Rambo was suffering what appeared to be multiple gunshot wounds to the upper body. Rambo was transported from the scene of the crime via ambulance and was later pronounced deceased shortly on arrival at Ochsner LSU Health Hospital.

Based on preliminary information gathered at the scene of the crime, authorities believe Rambo was unintentionally shot by men who were attempting to shoot another person present at the scene. The alleged shooters, after firing multiple rounds, fled the scene and were not immediately apprehended. Since the initial investigation began, detectives have worked tirelessly in efforts to identify and arrest those involved. As a result of those continuing efforts, three men have now been charged in the slaying. Jacody Wilson, 23, of the 3100 block of Lancaster Street was charged with felon in possession of a firearm and second degree murder. Carl McClinton 18, of the 3200 block of Knight Street was charged with second degree murder. Cortez Hines, 27 of the 1200 block of Crofton Street in Shreveport was also charged with second degree murder and felon in possession of a firearm. All men were booked into the Shreveport City Jail.
