## **Shreveport Police search for suspect in west Shreveport homicide**



**SUSPECT: Jerome Johnson**

Shreveport police are looking for a man accused of killing another in an early morning shooting.

On October 26, 2019, just after 4:00 a.m. Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to Willis Knighton Medical Center on reports of a 38-year-old male arriving at their facility suffering from a gunshot injury to the head. The victim arrived by private automobile and was then transported by ambulance to Ochsner LSU Health where he later succumbed to his injuries.

Shreveport Police Department's Homicide division immediately launched their investigation. Detectives determined that the shooting happened near Wallace Avenue and West 69<sup>th</sup> Street. Preliminary information suggested that there was an argument that preceded the shooting. No further details are being released at this time.

Through evidence collection and witness interviews detectives gathered enough information to procure an arrest warrant charging 44-year-old Jerome Johnson with the Second Degree Murder of the decedent. Bond was set at \$500,000.00. Jerome's last known address was in the 500 block of Browning Street.
