Police ask public's help to identify shooting suspects

Shreveport Police Violent Crimes Detectives are releasing video footage and images relevant to an early February shooting in west Shreveport.

On February 8th, 2020, just before 11:30 p.m., Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to investigate a shooting in the 4900 block of Mansfield Road. On arrival, officers located a 19-year-old male victim suffering from a gunshot injury to his leg. He was transported to Ochsner LSU Health Hospital with non-life threatening injuries. Officers were notified a short time later that a 31-year-old female had also arrived at Ochsner. She was suffering from a gunshot injury to the chest that was later determined to be non-life threatening.

Detectives responded and collected evidence from the crime scene, which included video from the store surveillance system. Surveillance footage showed two males approach the store and shortly after, fired multiple shots at a group of men on the parking lot. Following the shooting, the two men fled the scene on foot. The man that was struck was part of the group that the two men fired toward. The female victim was sitting in her car and had no connection to the group.

Police are asking anyone that can identify these two men to contact them at 318-673-7300 or 318-673-6955. Those wishing to submit information anonymously can do so by contacting Caddo Parish Crime Stoppers at 318-673-7373, lockemup.org, or via their app P3Tips. Crime Stoppers pays cash rewards for information leading to the arrest of individual(s) responsible for crimes.
