Shreveport man sought on domestic battery charges

Shreveport Police investigators are seeking the whereabouts of a man accused of Domestic Battery charges.

On March 28, 2020, Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to the 2900 block of Kings Oak Loop relative to a domestic call. Upon arrival, officers made contact with a female victim who was suffering from a contusion to the left side of her face and several abrasions to her arms and hands. The victim advised she and her estranged boyfriend, 42-year-old Darius Powell, were involved in an argument that turned violent. Powell allegedly struck the victim with the face multiple times with a closed fist. Investigators procured a warrant for Powell's arrest, charging him with one count of Domestic Battery with Serious Bodily Injury.
