Shreveport man sought on domestic charges

Shreveport Police investigators are seeking the whereabouts of a man accused of Battery of a Dating Partner.

On January 29, 2020, Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to the 3200 block of Fulton Avenue relative to a domestic call. Upon arrival, officers made contact with a female victim who was suffering from several abrasions to her face and neck. The victim advised she and her estranged boyfriend, 24-year-old Kenyla Alford, were involved in an argument that turned violent. Alford allegedly grabbed the victim around the neck, in attempt to strangle her. Investigators procured a warrant for Alford's arrest, charging him with one count of Battery of a Dating Partner and one count of Battery of a Dating Partner with Child Endangerment.
