### **Police make arrest in connection with Thursday morning murder attempt**

Investigators with the Shreveport Police Departments Violent Crimes unit have jailed a man they believe responsible for shooting another man in west Shreveport.

On June 25, 2020, just after 11:00 a.m., Shreveport Police officers were called to the 3500 block of Cedar Creek Drive on reports of shots being fired. Arriving officers located witnesses that told them that at least two men were running through the complex and they heard shots being fired. As officers were in the process of searching for a crime scene, they were notified that a juvenile male had arrived at Willis Knighton South hospital with a gunshot injury to the upper body. His injuries were described as non-life threatening.

Investigators with the Crime Scene and Violent Crimes Units were called to the scene. Crime scene investigators collected video and other evidence from the scene while violent crimes investigators conducted interviews with the victim and witnesses. Police learned that the shooting stemmed from an argument over a gun. After a daylong investigation detectives procured an arrest warrant charging 19-year-old Briante Winn, from the 3200 block of Jackson Street, with one count of Attempted First Degree Murder. No bond was set.

Winn was taken into custody on June 26, 2020, and following interviews with investigators was booked into the Shreveport City Jail on his warrant.
