Police make arrest in afternoon domestic incident

Investigators with the Shreveport Police Department's Domestic Violence Unit have made an arrest in connection with a stabbing in west Shreveport yesterday afternoon.

On June 30, 2020, just after 4:30 p.m., Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to the 2600 block of Greenwood Road on reports of an individual who arrived at their facility suffering from a stab wound to the arm. The victim disclosed to arriving officers that he had been stabbed by his live in girlfriend.

Investigators with the Domestic Violence Unit were summoned and learned that the victim and his girlfriend, 44-year-old Curtidra Scott, engaged in an argument. During the argument, the victim said that Scott armed herself with a knife and attacked him. He advised detectives that he raised his arm in self-defense and was stabbed. He also suffered a broken arm in the attack.

Detectives and patrol officers went to the 3700 block of Jackson Street and made contact with the Scott. She was taken into custody and transported to the Shreveport Police Complex for interviews. Scott was subsequently booked into the Shreveport City Jail on one count of Aggravated 2nd Degree Battery and one count of Possession of Marijuana.

Our Domestic Violence Detectives work daily to ensure that perpetrators of domestic violence are held accountable and that the victims of those incidents receive the help that they need.
