Police make arrest in late May Homicide

The search has ended and a Shreveport man wanted in connection with the late May shooting death of a man in east Shreveport has surrendered himself to authorities.

On May 27, 2020, just after 2:00 p.m., Shreveport Police patrol officers were dispatched to 1901 Centenary Boulevard in reference to a shooting. They arrived on scene and found 28-year-old Travarrius Adams in a vehicle suffering from multiple gunshot injuries. Adams was transported to Ochners LSU Health where he later died.

Violent Crimes and Crime Scene Investigators responded to the scene and launched their investigation. Investigators learned that two vehicles pulled alongside each other on the parking lot of the apartment complex, shortly after gunfire erupted and Adams was struck. Detectives spoke with witnesses, procured video surveillance footage, and collected other evidence from the scene. Through an intensive investigative effort, investigators identified 25-year-old Antonio Johnson as the person believed to be responsible for the murder. A warrant procured charging Johnson with one count of Second Degree Murder. Bond was set at \$150,000.00. No further investigative details are being released at this time. Johnson has addresses in the 6500 block of Fairfield Avenue and the 2700 block of Myrtle Street.

On July 9, 2020. Johnson surrendered himself to the Caddo Correctional Center where he remains.
