## **Crime Stoppers tip leads to warrant for man believed responsible for theft from an elementary school in north Shreveport**

Investigators with the Shreveport Police Department's Property Crimes Unit are searching for a man believed responsible for a mid-June theft at Northside Elementary school.

On July 6, 2020, Caddo Parish School Board Maintenance workers filed a police report after noticing that several hundred feet of copper drain line pipes and 45 commercial grade AC Units had been stolen. Property Crimes Investigators immediately launched an investigation and were able to obtain video surveillance footage of the crime. The video showed that the theft occurred late in the night of June 14<sup>th</sup> and continued into the morning of June 15<sup>th</sup>. Investigators observed significant damage to the air conditioning units and learned that an estimated 2,000 pounds of copper had been taken. The total loss to the school was more than \$50,000.

Detectives released the video to Shreveport Caddo Parish Stoppers and following the video release received a tip identifying 46-year-old Terrance Clark, of the 1600 block of Andrew Street, as the person responsible. Through their ongoing investigation, they were able to validate the tip and subsequently procured a warrant for Clark charging him with one count of Felony Theft. Bond was set at \$50,000.
