## Arrest made in domestic violence incidents

Investigators with the Shreveport Police Department's Domestic Violence Unit have a man in custody accused of the late November beating of his estranged girlfriend at a north Shreveport apartment complex.

On February 27, 2020, just before 5:00 a.m., Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to reports of a domestic violence incident on North Hearne Avenue. Arriving officers made contact with the victim who disclosed that her ex-boyfriend, 24-year-old Treydarrius Wright, allegedly struck her in the face with a closed fist, strangled her, cut her with a knife, and took money from her. Wright's 5-month-old child was present during the commission of the battery but was not injured. Patrol officers photographed the victim's injuries which were non-life threatening.

Investigators with the Domestic Violence Unit were assigned to the case for follow up. Through their investigation, they were able to procure warrants for Wright charging him with one count of Aggravated Battery and one count of Domestic Abuse Battery Child Endangerment. No bond was set.

On April 4, 2020, Wright went to a home in west Shreveport and threatened a man with a firearm. There were no injuries and Wright fled the scene when the homeowner armed himself to defend the people in his residence from danger.

Investigators with the Violent Crimes were assigned to follow up on the April incident. Through their investigation, they were able to procure a warrant for Wright charging him with one count of Aggravated Assault. His bond was set at \$10,000.00.

On July 16<sup>th</sup> Wright was taken into custody by the Bossier Parish Sheriff's Office and extradited to the Caddo Correctional Center where he remains.
