Police charge man in residential burglary

Investigators with the Shreveport Police Department's Tactical Robbery Unit have charged a man with home invasion following an incident last week in Shreveport's Southern Trace neighborhood

On July 22, 2020, just before 4:00 p.m., Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to reports of a burglary in the 11000 block of Seville Quarters. The victim reported that she was in bed and heard a strange noise. When she went to investigate, she observed a white male standing in a bedroom in the home. The suspect allegedly charged toward the victim and as she made it to the front door noticed that the man was no longer chasing her. The suspect, later identified as 38-year-old Christopher Taylor, fled the home but took multiple pieces of jewelry and cash from the residence.

Investigators with the Tactical Robbery Unit were assigned to the case. They were able to gather information that led them to identify Taylor as the individual they believed responsible. Taylor was apprehended by the Caddo Parish Sheriff's Office last night. Robbery investigators charged him with one count of Simple Burglary of an Inhabited Dwelling relative to this incident.

Taylor has been charged for multiple offenses by Shreveport Police in the past. Those include Aggravated Burglary, Simple Burglary of an Inhabited Dwelling, Simple Burglary, and theft.
