Shreveport Police are searching for a senior citizen who fled from a vehicle in downtown Shreveport a little over an hour ago.

On August 6, 2020, just before 8:00 p.m., Jennie Beck fled from her daughter's vehicle at Crockett Street and Common Street in downtown Shreveport. Beck's daughter was transporting her to the hospital for evaluation due to dementia related problems. Beck suffers from Alzheimer's disease and believes she is in California.

Beck is a white female who is 5'6" tall and weighs 145 pounds. She has brown eyes and short, thin, gray hair. She was wearing a white short-sleeved striped shirt, light blue capri pants, and sandals
