Police investigate early morning homicide

Shreveport Police detectives are investigating an early morning shooting in west Shreveport that left a man dead.

On September 1, 2020, just before 6:00 a.m., Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to reports of a man that had possibly been shot behind a residence in the 3400 block of Clarke Boulevard. Arriving officers located a male victim, in his forties, in the back yard of the residence. He had been shot multiple times and died at the scene. The Caddo Parish Coroner's Office took custody of the decedent.

Investigators with the Crime Scene and Violent Crimes Unit were called to the scene. Crime Scene investigators collected shell casings and other evidence while detectives spent the day canvassing the neighborhood in an attempt to locate witnesses.

Detectives are asking anyone with information about this homicide to call Shreveport Police immediately at 318-673-6955 or 318-673-7300 #3. Those that wish to remain anonymous can submit information to Shreveport Caddo Crime Stoppers at 318-673-7373 or via their app, P3Tips. Crime Stoppers will pay a \$2,000.00 minimum reward for information leading to the identification and arrest of the person(s) responsible for this crime. Remember Crime Stoppers only wants your information, not your name.

The Caddo parish Coroner's Office will release the decedent's name at a later time.
