Two men arrested following morning shooting incident

Shreveport Police patrol officers have arrested two men after an exchange of gunfire in west Shreveport this morning.

On October 7, just before 10:30 a.m., Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to the 7200 block of Suntan Street on reports of shots being fired. Concerned callers informed 911 dispatchers that several black males were shooting at each other in the neighborhood.

Arriving officers were able to make contact with two men, Roderick Wallace (DOB 2-6-1989) and Reginald Davis (DOB 3-14-2001). Wallace fled from officers but was apprehended following a brief foot pursuit. Wallace was found to be in possession of a handgun. Reginald Davis was also apprehended and during their on scene investigation officers learned that Davis fired a weapon at individuals who were allegedly firing at him. Davis was unable to give a description of the suspects. Multiple vehicles and homes were struck during the exchange of gunfire but luckily, no one was injured. Officers were able to located Davis's gun inside of a residence in the block.

Patrol officers documented the scene with digital photographs and collected everything of evidentiary value, including the two firearms. Reginald Davis was charged with one count of Illegal Use of a Weapon. Roderick Wallace is a convicted felon and was charged with one count of Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon. Both men were booked into the Shreveport City Jail on their charges.
