Police continue investigation into weekend homicide

Shreveport Police Homicide detectives are continuing their investigation into a Sunday morning shooting that left a man dead and a teen injured.

On October 18, 2020 just before 4:00 a.m., Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to the 400 block of West 74th Street on reports of a shooting. Arriving officers located 36-year-old Michael Wilson suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. He was transported to Ochsner LSU Health Hospital where he later succumbed to his injuries. While on scene, officers learned that a juvenile female who was in a nearby residence was struck by stray gunfire while she slept. She was also transported to Ochsner LSU Health Hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

Investigators with the Homicide and Crime Scene Investigations Unit were summoned and launched their investigation. CSIU collected evidence from the scene and detectives canvassed the neighborhood searching for witnesses. No other information has been released at this time.
