Late night dispute leaves one man dead another in custody

A shooting in south Shreveport has tragically claimed the life of a man following an altercation.

On November 4, 2020, just after 11:00 p.m., Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to reports of a shooting in the 9000 block of Youree Drive at Circle K. Arriving officers contacted 31-year-old Oquez Allen who was suffering from multiple gunshot injuries to the lower body. Allen was transported to Ochsner LSU Health by the Shreveport Fire Department Medics with what was described as life-threatening injuries. He later died from his injuries. Patrol officers detained a suspect, identified as Devin Adams (05/12/1996 DOB) at the scene.

Investigators with the Violent Crimes Bureau were summoned and worked through the night interviewing witnesses and reviewing video surveillance. Through their investigation, they learned that Adams and the victim engaged in a verbal altercation while at this location. Following the verbal altercation, Adams produced a firearm, and shot Allen multiple times in the abdomen. After an interview with Adams, detectives charged him with one count of Second Degree Murder. Adams was booked into the Shreveport City Jail.
