Shreveport man jailed after allegedly beating man severely unconscious

On November 13, 2020 at around 3:00 a.m., patrol officers responded to the 3700 block of Sumner Street relative to a person lying on the ground. Officers located an unconscious male with several bleeding and trauma injuries to the head. The victim, identified as 50-year-old Freddie Edwards, was immediately transported to Ochsner LSU Health with possible life threatening injuries.

Violent crimes investigators were summoned to this location and immediately launched an investigation into this incident. Based on witness information and evidence that was obtained, investigators learned that the victim was severely beaten by possibly two black males. Using this information, investigators were able to identify one of the suspects as Adrienne Mims (DOB 12-14-1980).

An arrest warrant was procured for Adrienne Mims charging him with one count of Attempted Second Degree Murder. On November 16, 2020, Detectives located Mims at a location in west Shreveport. Following an interview, he was booked into the Shreveport City Jail.
