Multiple arrests made in Late November Homicide

Shreveport Police have charged multiple individuals in a late November homicide that occurred in the 6100 block of Lexington Avenue.

Back on November 29, 2020, just after 02:30 a.m., Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to the 6100 block of Lexington Avenue relative to a shooting. Arriving officers located 20-year old Tearence Washington lying in the roadway suffering from a life-threatening gunshot injury to the upper body. The victim had succumbed to his injury.

Violent Crimes and Crime Scene Investigators were summoned to the scene. Through their investigation, it was learned that Washington was killed when the suspects were in the commission of shooting up a residence in the 6100 block of Lexington Avenue. After following leads, investigators have identified the suspects involved in this homicide. Detectives procured arrest warrants for Jayron Kelly (11/17/2000), and Christian Gandy (09-26-01). Both were charged with one count of Second Degree Murder. A 17 year old juvenile is also being charged in connection with this homicide.

Investigators along with the assistance of the United States Marshal's Task Force were quickly able to apprehended Jayron Kelly and Christian Gandy. Both suspects were booked into the Shreveport City Jail. Bond is set at \$500,000 on both Kelly and Gandy
