Sunday Morning shooting leaves one dead and another injured



Unidentified Suspect

An early Sunday morning shooting has left one man dead and a female injured in west Shreveport.

On December 6, 2020, just before 2:30 a.m., Shreveport Police responded to the 4000 block of Jewella Avenue at the Clark gas station relative to a shooting. Officers located a 22 year old male who had sustained a single gunshot injury to the upper body. The male was immediately transported to Ochsner LSU Health with life threatening injuries where he later died. Officers also located a 21 year old female who sustained multiple abrasions to the body. She was also transported to Ochsner LSU Health with non-life threatening injuries.

Violent Crimes and Crime Scene Investigators were summoned to the scene. Investigators collected evidence and interviewed multiple witnesses. Preliminary information suggests that both of the victims had engaged in a physical altercation with multiple unknown black male suspects while at this location. During the altercation, one of the suspects produced a firearm and shot the male victim. Detectives were able to retrieve surveillance video from the business and have released the attached images of a suspect and the vehicle that may be directly involved in this homicide.

Police are asking the public's help in identifying this suspect and vehicle.
