**RESOLUTION NO. 145 OF 2020**

**A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE PAY PLAN FOR GENERAL CLASSIFIED EMPLOYEES TO PROVIDE A ONE TIME LUMP SUM PAY INCREASE AND OTHERWISE PROVIDING RESPECT THERETO**

WHEREAS, the general classified employees of the City of Shreveport did not receive a pay increase for several years because the City did not have sufficient funds for pay increases in exchange for services rendered to the City of Shreveport; and

WHEREAS, the City does not have sufficient funds to authorize a permanent pay increase for said employees for the year 2021, but funding is available for a one time pay increase in lieu of permanent cost of living, merit or other pay raise; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, with the approval of the Mayor, will amend the City's 2020 budgets to include funding for a \$1,000 for full-time employees and \$500 for part-time employees, actively employed as of December 1, 2020

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Shreveport, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that the pay plan for general classified employees is hereby amended as follows:

1. A one-time salary increase of \$1,000 shall be paid to all full-time classified employees, non-civil service employees, Police civil service employees above the rank of Captain or Fire civil service employees above the rank of Battalion Chief, who are actively employed as of December 1, 2020 and those not scheduled to receive a 2021 pay increase.
2. A one-time salary increase of \$500 shall be paid to all part-time employees who are actively employed as of December 1, 2020.
3. This one-time payment shall be due and payable on a paycheck before December 25, 2020, with said amount to be added to the regular salary or wages of each eligible employee and subject to all usual and customary taxes and deductions.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if any provision or item of this resolution or the application thereof is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions, items or application of this resolution which can be given effect without the invalid provisions, items or application and, to this end, the provisions of this resolution are hereby declared servable; and

**A RESOLUTION TO INITIATE A COUNCIL INVESTIGATION OF THE HEALTH CARE TRUST FUND BOARD AS AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 4.29 OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF SHREVEPORT CONCERNING THE MANAGEMENT AND OVERSIGHT OF THE CITY'S HEALTH BENEFITS PLAN AND TO OTHERWISE PROVIDE WITH RESPECT THERETO**

WHEREAS, Section 4.29 of the Charter authorizes the council or any committee thereof when authorized by the Council, to investigate the official conduct of any office, department, commission, board or agency of the city government or of any officer of employee thereof; and WHEREAS, Section 66-141 of the City of Shreveport's Code of Ordinances, provides that the City shall contribute 70 percent; and eligible active employee shall contribute 30 percent to the health care trust fund and further that in the event there are two or more alternative health care delivery programs, the city shall contribute an amount equal to 70 percent of the lowest rate for that tier or classification; and

WHEREAS, Section 66-141 as above stated was in effect during all time periods applicable to the desired investigation; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Council that City contributions made to the employee health care trust fund for a period of approximately 10 years prior to the initiation of this desired investigation were substantially more than authorized by Section 66-141 of the Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, because of these findings, the Council has determined it necessary to initiate an investigation of the City's Health Care Trust Fund Board concerning the management and oversight of the city's health benefits plan for the purposes of determining the extent of loss by the City as a result of overpayments to the health care trust fund and the source of any directives authorizing said overpayments.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Shreveport in due, legal and regular session convened that it authorizes the initiation of an investigation of the Health Care Trust Fund Board of the City of Shreveport pursuant to Section 4.29 of the Charter of the City of Shreveport for the reasons stated herein.

WHEREAS, the City of Shreveport (“City”) is the owner of immovable property (i.e. real property) located in the 1500 Block of Texas Avenue with City Plat #171401-48-4 in Caddo Parish; and

WHEREAS, the City, in Resolution No. 123 of 2020, declared the 1500 Block of Texas City Plat #171401-48-4 as surplus property and it is not needed for public purposes in accordance with Shreveport City Code 26-291 (f); and

WHEREAS, selling this Property will allow for development of the property and allows the City to repurpose all proceeds of the sale for the benefit of the community; and

WHEREAS, before disposition can be made of City-owned immovable property (i.e. real property) under the provisions of La. R.S. 33:4712(B) the following is required an ordinance must be introduced: (1) giving the reasons for the action on the part of the governing authority, (2) fixing the minimum price and (3) terms of the sale, lease, exchange, or other contract to be made with reference to the property; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Shreveport City Charter Section 2.03(a) the City may sell immovable property (i.e. real property); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Shreveport City Charter Section 2.03(a), no real property or rights to real property shall be sold by the City except upon sealed bids or at public auction and after due advertisement, all as the City Council may from time to time determine and direct; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Shreveport City Charter Sec. 10.07, all sales made by the Purchasing Agent shall be made on the basis of competitive bids after such public notice as may be prescribed by the City Council by Ordinance and all sales shall be to the highest responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, “[t]he sale of surplus public property shall be by competitive bids after public notice” pursuant to Shreveport City Code Sec. 26-292; and

WHEREAS, Article VII, §14 of the Louisiana Constitution of 1974, provides that except as otherwise provided, the property or things of value of the City shall not be loaned, pledged, or donated to any person, association, or corporation, public or private, and therefore it can be said that Section 14 mandates that, at a minimum, a public entity must recover fair market value when selling surplus immovable property (i.e. real property); and

WHEREAS, the initial appraisal identified the market value of the Property as NINE THOUSAND FOUR DOLLARS (\$9,400); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Shreveport, Louisiana, in due, regular and legal session convened, that:

1. Resolution No. 123 of 2020, declared that the City-owned immovable property located in the 1500 Block of Texas Avenue with City Plat #171401-48-4 in Caddo Parish, (hereafter referred to as the “Property”), is surplus property and is not needed for public purposes. Shreveport City Code 26-291 (f).
2. As required by La. R.S. 33:4712(B), it is hereby stated that it has been determined by this City Council that it is in the best interest of the City to sell the Property.
3. The Appraisal is attached hereto and made part hereof as Exhibit “A”.

4. In accordance with Shreveport City Charter Section 2.03(a) the Purchasing Agent, and/or her designee, is hereby authorized to advertise for and solicit sealed bids and to sell the Property, to the highest responsible bidder under the terms, substantially in accordance with IFB #20-0\_\_ attached hereto and made part hereof as Exhibit "B".
5. As required by law and the MINIMUM BID PRICE, for the sale of the Property, shall be fixed and set at NINE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$9,400), which is the appraised fair market value of the property as of September 3, 2020.
6. Pursuant to Shreveport City Charter Sec. 10.07, all sales made by the Purchasing Agent shall be made on the basis of competitive bids after such public notice as may be prescribed by law and all sales shall be to the highest responsible bidder.
7. As required by La. R.S. 33:4712(B), the Property, including any and all improvements, is described as: City-owned immovable property (i.e. real property) located in the 1500 Block of Texas Avenue with City Plat #171401-48-4 in Caddo Parish.
8. This is the first advertised attempt to sell this property.
9. To the extent permitted by law, the City shall reserve unto itself all oil, gas and other minerals and mineral rights, whatsoever, in, on or under the described Property to be transferred.
10. To the extent permitted by law, the City shall reserve unto itself all air rights, whatsoever, in or above the described Property to be transferred to the extent it does not infringe on federal regulations or statutory impositions.
11. The sale of the Property shall be "AS IS". There shall be no warranty of fitness, condition or title. The City does not warrant the use of the property for any particular purpose.
