Multiple business robberies result in 2 arrests

Two individuals are behind bars today following a string of business robberies. On February 9, 2021, at around 12:30 a.m. Shreveport Police received the initial report of an armed business robbery at the Circle K located in the 400 block of Kings Highway. A male and female suspect entered the business armed with a firearm and demanded money. They were last seen leaving in a white Nissan car with unknown Texas tags.

A short time later, Shreveport Police received additional reports of multiple armed business robberies of Circle K stores throughout Shreveport. According to each report, the suspects were reported as a female and male suspect. In each robbery, a firearm was produced when the suspects demanded money and/or cigarettes leaving with an undisclosed amount of cash. A white Nissan car was reported leaving each of the scenes.

At around 4:00 a.m., Shreveport Police received a report of a suspicious grey Nissan SUV located at the Circle K on Linwood Avenue/West 70th Street. Officers with the assistance of Caddo Parish Sheriff Office Deputies quickly responded to this location. When officers arrived, they located an adult female and a 17-year-old male juvenile who they apprehended. The adult female was identified as Lyneisha Clark.

Investigators with the Tactical Robbery Unit responded to all of the Circle K locations which had been involved to conduct follow-up investigations. After obtaining evidence from all of the Circle K stores, Investigators interviewed both Lyneisha Clark and the male juvenile. Detectives determined that the suspects switched vehicles at some point and time. The grey Nissan Rogue that the suspects were located in was reported as stolen and later impounded.

Following an interview with investigators, both Clark and the juvenile were charged with five counts of Armed Robbery. Clark was booked into the Shreveport City Jail and the juvenile was booked into the Caddo Juvenile Detention Center.

None of the Circle K employees were reported injured. The following Circle K stores were involved: 400 Kings Highway, 5800 Line Avenue, 1000 Shreveport Barksdale Highway, 3700 Pines Road, and Linwood Avenue/West 70th Street.
