## **Water Department restores service**

The Water Department restores water service except for a few isolated areas in the city. These areas are primarily, West Shreveport on the extreme side of West 70<sup>th</sup> and some residences along Buncombe Road.

Crews are now able to access elevated storage tanks at Pines and 70<sup>th</sup> and customers should see their pressure increase throughout the morning.

Some areas of Highland, which were without water yesterday, now have water and that's the same for Queensborough.

"Everyone should have water by noon," said William Daniel. "If they don't, it could be a line break that we are not aware of, or a private problem."

The hospitals have sufficient pressure to operate and the Department will be increasing the pressure to them throughout the day.

The Department is preparing to take water samples and hope to lift the boil advisory by Saturday.

Call 318-673-7600 if you don't have water, so it can be determined if it is a public or private issue.
